

GUIDELINES

Costume drop off: through September

- Drop off clean, new and gently used costumes for kids and teens at the Children's Desk any time during the month of September. Receive a voucher for each full costume donated.
- Guidelines for donations:
 - Costumes accepted for kids from birth to high school.
 - Costumes should be in excellent to good condition: no rips, tears or stains (unless they belong on the costume); in clean and wearable condition (e.g. no broken zippers or missing buttons).
 - No wigs or used/opened makeup
 - Accessories accepted but not valid for Costume Swap vouchers.
- No costume to donate? No problem. You'll still be able to pick out a costume during the second hour of the event on Oct 6.

Costume Swap: Sat Oct 6

- 10-11 am: For voucher holders only. Bring your Costume Swap voucher to the library's lower level. Each voucher is good for one full costume. To choose additional costumes, you must wait until after 11 am.
- 11 am-noon: Open to all. Choose from any of the remaining costumes to outfit your child at no cost.

Notes

- For each donation of one full costume, receive one Costume Swap voucher. The library reserves the right to decide if a donated costume meets "full costume" rule.
- The library does not guarantee that patrons will find a costume in their size or fit.
- Swapping is first-come, first-served; please be respectful of other swappers and only swap for what you need.
- Costumes may be tried on at the swap; we suggest you wear something you can slip a costume over to save time. There will not be additional private space to try on costumes.
- Any leftover costumes will be donated or saved for another swap event.
