

**Supplies needed:**

- Disposable protective gloves
- Alcohol inks in variety of colors
- Rubbing alcohol
- Ceramic tiles
- Cotton balls
- Hair dryer (optional)
- Liquitex varnish

Directions

1. Put on gloves.
2. Select three or four colors of ink.
3. Use a cotton ball to wipe rubbing alcohol over the surface of the tile.
4. While the tile is still wet, drip one drop each of your chosen ink colors on the tile.
5. Watch while the ink colors spread and interact.
6. Once color movement has stopped, use a hair dryer to speed the drying of the ink (if desired, or let air-dry).
7. When ink is completely dry and no longer shiny, use another cotton ball to wipe a small amount of Liquitex varnish over the top of the tile.
8. Remove and dispose of the gloves.
9. When varnish is dry, take two magnet squares, peel off the backing and stick them to the back of the tile.
