

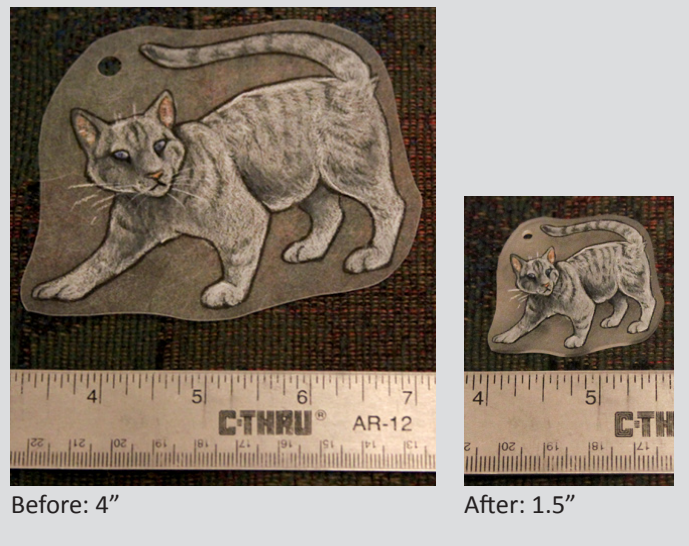


Supplies needed:

- Shrinky Dink plastic*
- Scissors
- Permanent markers
- Oven
- Cookie sheet
- Baking paper
- Design to trace (optional)
- Hole punch (optional)
- Jewelry hardware (optional)

<p>1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. (Note: Only Idea Studio staff are allowed to work the oven; notify staff on hand before starting your project.)</p>	<p>2. Choose or plan a design. For a more-finished look, use Sharpies to color in the interior spaces before outlining with black. Colors will become more vibrant when baked.</p>
<p>3. Cut out your design with scissors. If you want a hole in your finished product, use hole punch BEFORE baking. Remember: Shrinky Dinks will shrink to about 1/3 their pre-baking size and will be thick and hard. The design cannot be cut after baking.</p>	<p>4. When oven is ready, line a baking sheet with parchment or freezer paper. Place the Shrinky Dink design on the paper.</p>
<p>5. Bake for 1-3 minutes, depending on size. During baking, Shrinky Dinks will curl up and then flatten out. After they flatten, wait 30 more seconds and pull them out. Let cool.</p>
