


Easel – Importing an SVG File


Step 1: Find and save an SVG file

- Use the Technique Tutorial “Searching for Vector Files” to find and save a file of your choice.




Step 2: Open the Import dialog box

- After you have saved the file, return to Easel.
- Click on the “Import” icon at the bottom of the left-hand toolbar.
- From the menu that pops up, select “SVG”



Step 3: Find and open your file

- In the box that pops up, locate your file and click “Open”
- Files generally save in the “Downloads” folder. If you do not see your file, use the left-hand toolbar to be sure you are looking in the right folder.



Step 4: Make any further changes in Easel

- The image will now open in Easel and can be treated like any other shape. See Technique Tutorial “Easel – Working with Shapes” for further guidance.
