

Searching for Vector Files

Step 1: Begin an image search

- Go to <https://images.google.com/>
- Enter your desired search term(s)




Step 2: Add the search limiter

- After your search term(s), type **filetype:svg**
- Press the "Enter" key to begin the search




Step 3: Begin the saving process

- Click on the desired picture to select it
- Right-click on the larger version of the picture
- Select "Save picture as"



Step 4: Check the file format

- In the dialog box that opens, check to see the file type
- In this case it is a PNG file, not an SVG file. This is therefore not a vector file itself. In these cases the actual vector file may often be accessed by clicking on the image and finding a way to download the vector file from the website that opens.



Step 5: If it is an SVG file, go ahead and save it

- If the file type is "Scalable Vector Graphics (*.svg)", click the "Save" button
