

## Serger – Changing Threads

<ul> <li>Step 1: Clip the old thread</li> <li>At the spool stand on the back of the serger, clip the thread to be changed.</li> <li>Note, this tutorial demonstrates changing a single thread. To change all the thread, simply perform these same steps on all four threads at the same time.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Step 2: Tie in the new one</li> <li>Remove the old spool from its stand and replace it with the new one</li> <li>Tie the end of the new thread to the end of the old one</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Step 3: Run the serger</li> <li>Without using fabric, run the serger to pull the new thread along its path.</li> <li>Pull lightly on the thread tail to help extend the threads faster.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Step 4: If needed, hand-thread the needle</li> <li>If replacing one or both of the needle threads, the knot will frequently not go through the eye of the needle.</li> <li>In that case, lift the presser foot to release tension on the thread, cut the new thread just above the knot, lower the presser foot again, and hand-thread the needle.</li> </ul>
