 Step 1: Open Silhouette Studio Double-click on the Silhouette Studio icon to open the program. The "Page Setup" panel automatically opens along the righthand side of the screen. 	Nexa Series
 Step 2: Changing page size Use the "Width" and Height" to change the page size to match your material. 12" is the maximum width the Silhouette can cut. For material without a backing, such as paper or cardstock, 12" is also the maximum height.
